SCECINA GRAD HONORED WITH SPORTS AWARD

Kelly McMasters named Athlete of the Year

August 25, 2010: Kelly McMasters graduated from Scecina Memorial High School in May, ending a distinguished high school career that culminated in her receiving a prestigious Lilly Endowment Scholarship. Recognition for her high school achievements did not end with her graduation, however, as she was named the Spirit of Sport Athlete of the Year by St. Vincent Sports Performance in July.

The award is given to student-athletes who demonstrate St. Vincent's six core values of service, reverence, integrity, wisdom, creativity and dedication.

A rare four-sport athlete, McMasters competed in volleyball, soccer, basketball and track, but the award also recognized her academic and service accomplishments. She was a member of the National Honor Society, participated in plays and musicals, the math team and student council, while also serving as the photo editor for the yearbook and student newspaper. Despite all of her time commitments, she excelled in the classroom, finishing ranked fifth in her class with an 8.35 grade-point average on an 8.0 scale.

McMasters will continue to pursue her love of the arts as she studies graphic design and photography at Ball State University this fall.
